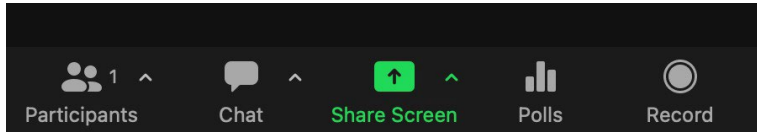
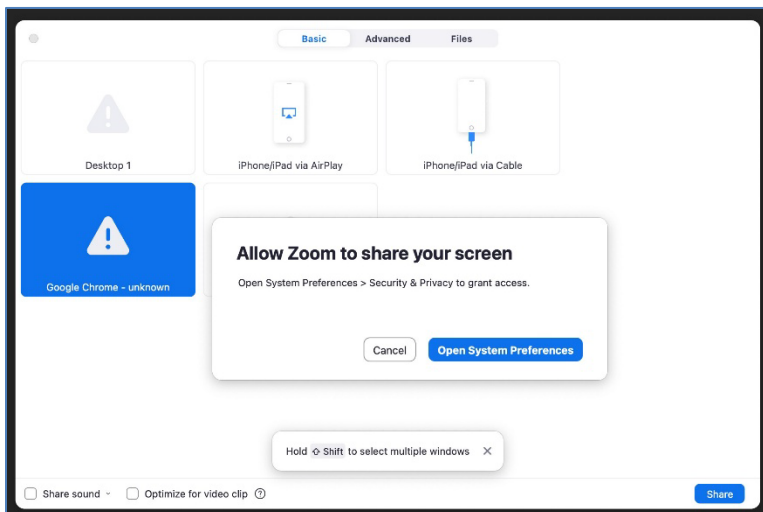


## Managing Apple security to allow screen sharing

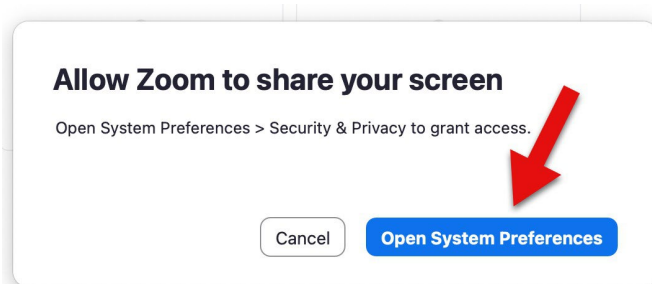
Want to share your screen on a Mac? But, when you click on the green “Share Screen” button you see a window with faded exclamation marks?



- Double click on one of the boxes with a faded exclamation mark. It will turn blue, and a box will pop on your screen.



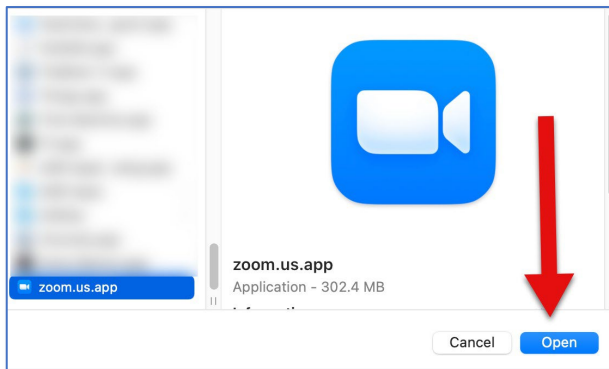
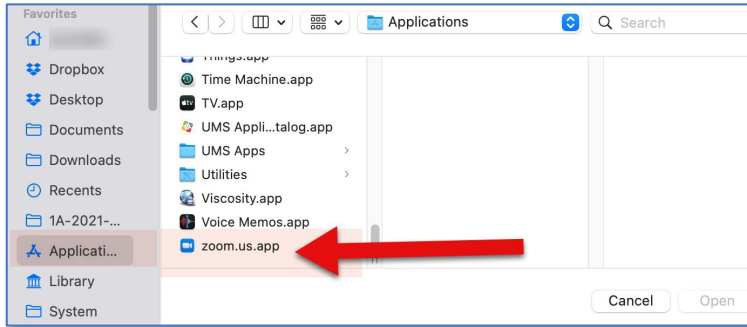
- In the box “Allow Zoom to share your screen,” click on “Open System Preferences.”



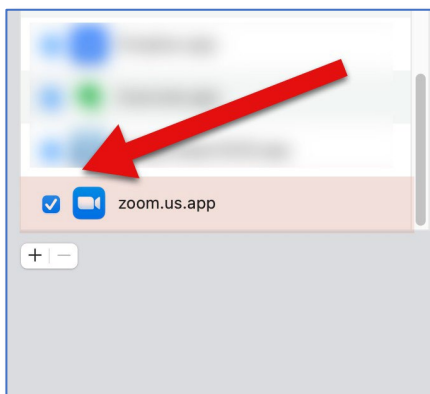
Note: Another way to open System Preferences is by clicking on the gear icon in your Mac menu bar.



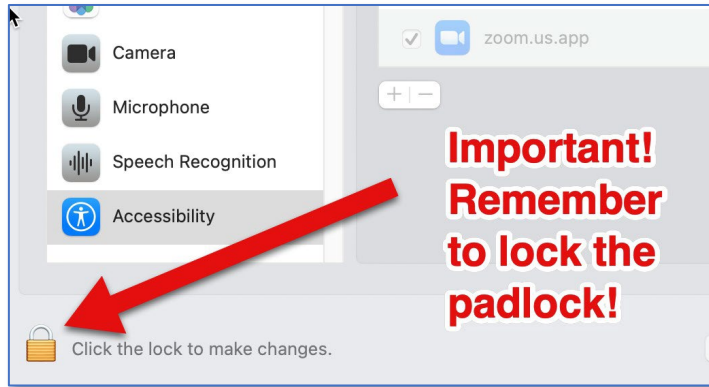
- Your computer will open “Applications” and you can select Zoom from the list.



- With the Zoom application Selected, click the “Open” button.
- Zoom will be added to your “Screen recording” menu. (You will also see a check mark next to the app.)



- Relock the padlock before closing “Security and Privacy” settings.



- Launch your Zoom program and test screen sharing to make sure you are now able to show your screen in a Zoom class!
