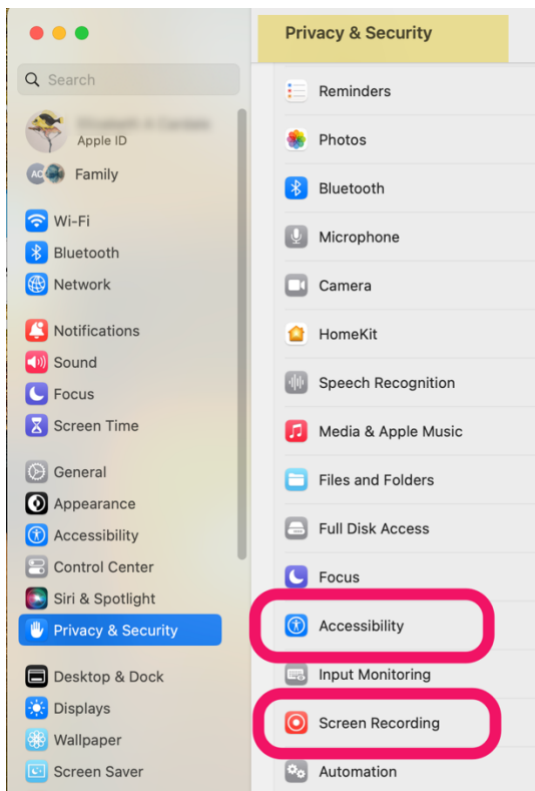
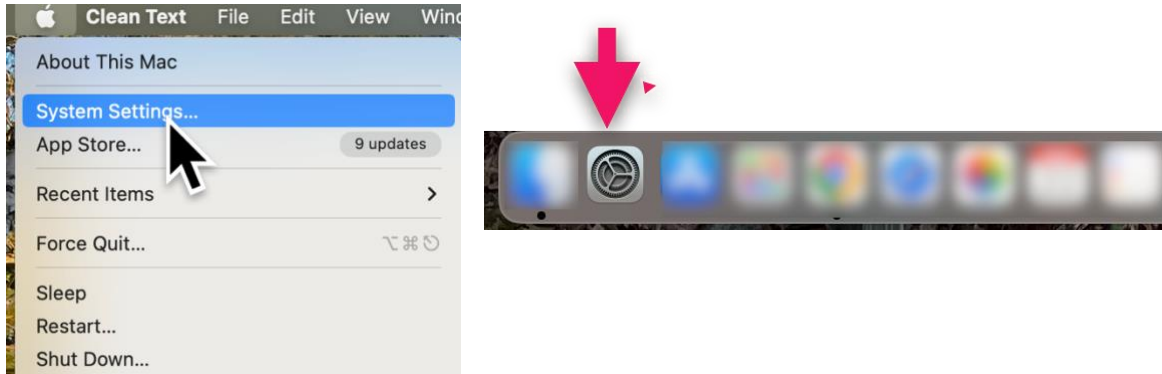


MacOS Zoom settings modifications for a new Mac (macOS Ventura 13)

Change Privacy & Security Advanced settings on Mac

Open System Settings by clicking on the Apple icon or the System Settings icon



Your settings menu will open.

Scroll down to “Privacy & Security”

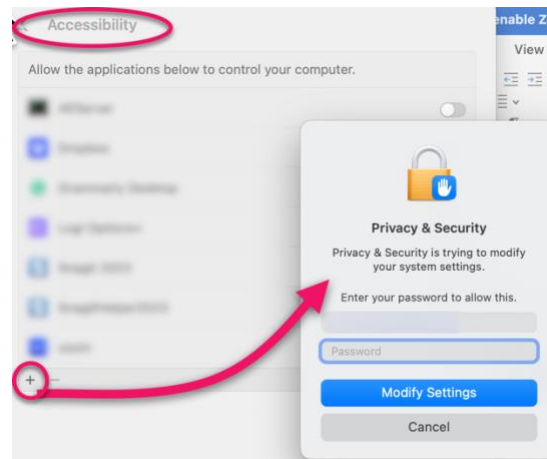
Click to open this menu.

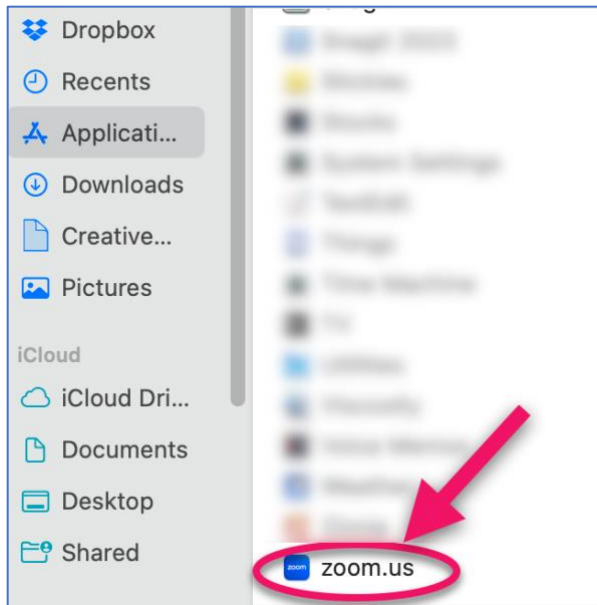
You can now change the settings for “Accessibility” and “Screen Recording”

Open **Accessibility** Settings

Click on the plus sign at the bottom.

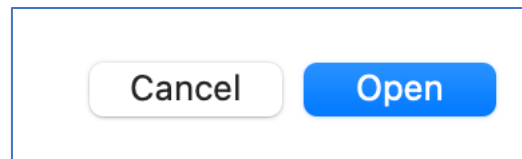
Now enter the user ID and password you use to open your mac. **NEXT** – Click “**Modify Settings**”



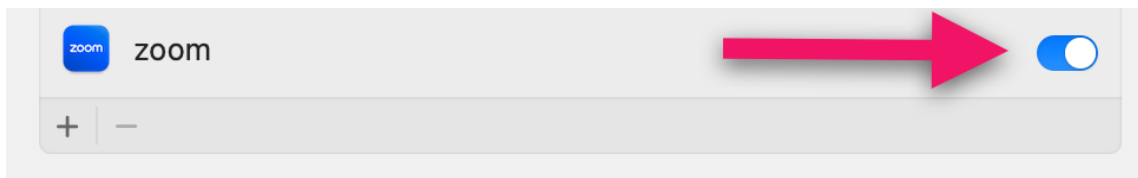


Select the Zoom app from your applications list.

Click the **“Zoom.us”**
Now click on **“Open”** in the bottom right corner of the applications panel.



You will return to **Accessibility** and see that Zoom has been added to the list. Make sure that you switch the app on by sliding the button on the right. (Blue = on)



Repeat the procedure to add Zoom to **Screen Recording**
